

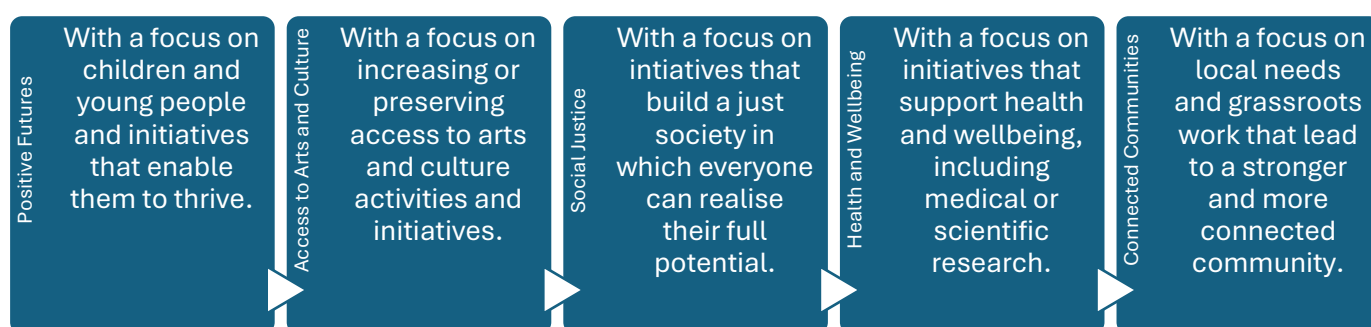
# THE WILLIAM ANGLISS CHARITABLE FUND

We aim to realise Sir William Angliss's desire to make a lasting and ongoing contribution to the community by funding charitable organisations in Victoria and Queensland. Through this funding we hope to support the strength and resilience of small, local community groups and efforts, as well as those serving on a larger scale.

### AREAS OF FOCUS



### FUNDING STREAMS

We support work that meets an immediate need as well as that which seeks to build the capacity of individuals or a collective to address a social need. We have three funding streams that cut across our five areas of focus:

Queensland Grants	Victoria - Small Grants (not accepting applications in 2025)	Victoria - Delivery and capacity building
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• One off grants of under \$3,000 for work taking place in Queensland.</li><li>• May include projects or work across any/all our areas of focus.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Supports core capacity and needs of organisations that meet an immediate/local need</li><li>• Small, practical grants of \$5k- \$10k delivered through a one-off gift.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Supports service delivery, testing new solutions as well as work that seeks to build the capacity of individuals or groups/movements.</li><li>• Grants of \$10k - \$150k for one year (new applicants may only apply for up to \$25k).</li></ul>

We aim to honour Sir William's legacy by grounding our granting in core values of community, service, innovation and strong leadership.

We also intend to deliver our funding in a way that demonstrates humility and trust in those we fund and a collaborative, responsive and agile way of working.
